

The Conjoint Bachelor of Arts and Commerce (BA/BCom – 540 points)

1. Version

- (a) These Regulations came into force on 1 January 2022.
- (b) This degree was first offered in 2021.

2. Variations

In exceptional circumstances the Amo Matua, Toi Tangata | Executive Dean of Arts or delegate, in consultation with the Amo Matua, Umanga | Executive Dean of Business or delegate, may approve a variation of these regulations. The Amo Matua

be credited with a minimum of 255 points from courses from Schedule V to the Bachelor of Arts regulations, including:

- i. at least 180 points above 100-level; and
 - ii. at least 90 points at 300-level; and
 - iii. two courses from Schedule C to the Bachelor of Arts; and
 - iv. the requirements for one major and one minor, as listed in Schedule S to the Bachelor of Arts.
- (c) be credited with a minimum of 255 points from courses in Schedule V to the Bachelor of Commerce regulations including:
- i. at least 165 points above 100-level; and
 - ii. at least 75 points at 300-level; and
