

# The Conjoint Bachelor of Arts and Science (BA/BSc – 540 points)

## 1. Version

- (a) These Regulations came into force on 1 January 2022.
- (b) This degree was first offered in 2021.

## 2. Variations

In exceptional circumstances the Amo Matua, Toi Tangata | Executive Dean of Arts or delegate, in consultation with the Amo Matua, P tāiao | Executive Dean of Science or delegate, may approve a variation of these regulations.

## 3. The structure of the qualification

To qualify for the Conjoint Bachelor of Arts and Science, a student must:

- (a) be credited with a minimum of 540 points towards the qualification; and
- (b) be credited with a minimum of 255 points from courses from Schedule V to the Bachelor of Arts regulations; including:
  - i. at least 180 points above 100-level; and
  - ii. at least 90 points at 300-level; and
  - iii. two courses from Schedule C to the Bachelor of Arts; and
