9. Honours, Distinction and Merit

10. Pathways to other qualifications

- (a) There are no advancing allocations for this degree.
- (b) A student who has completed the requirements for the Master of European Union Studies may also be eligible for the Postgraduate Certificate in Arts or the Postgraduate Diploma in Arts, which may be applied for by the Dean of the Faculty of Arts. The Dean of the Faculty of Arts may provide the necessary information for the allocation for the allocation.
