

Regulations for the Diploma in Education (D.Ed. 120)

These regulations must be read in conjunction with the General Regulations for the University.

1. Introduction

- (a) These Regulations came into force on 1 January 2025.
- (b) This Diploma was first offered in 2009.

2. Exceptional Circumstances

In exceptional circumstances the Amō Matua, Ako | Executive Dean of Education or delegate may approve a personal programme of study which does not conform to these Regulations.

10. Eligibility
- (a) A student who has completed the requirements for the Postgraduate Diploma in Education but has not yet graduated, may apply to the Amo Matua, Ako | Executive Dean of Education or delegate to be admitted to the Master of Education and have credits transferred.
 - (b) A student who has graduated with the Postgraduate Diploma in Education from Te Whare Wānanga o Waitaha | University of Canterbury, may apply to the Amo Matua, Ako | Executive Dean of Education or delegate to be admitted to the Master of Education and have their Diploma subsumed according to the General Regulations to the University.
 - (c) A student for the Postgraduate Diploma in Education who has not met the requirements for the Diploma but who has satisfied all requirements for the Postgraduate Certificate in Education or the Postgraduate Certificate in Tertiary Teaching, may apply to the Amo Matua, Ako | Executive Dean of Education or delegate to withdraw from the Diploma and be awarded the relevant Certificate.
