  - iii. 30 points from Schedule E: Elective Courses for the Degree of Master of Criminal Justice; and
- (b) a student's programme of study must be approved by the Amo Matua, Ture | Executive Dean of Law or delegate

# 4. Admission to the quali cation

To be admitted to this quali cation, a student must:

#### (a) have:

- quali ed for the degree of Bachelor of Criminal Justice or equivalent degree from an Aotearoa New Zealand University with a B Grade Average or better in at least 90 points of 300-level courses; o
- ii. quali ed for any other degree from an Aotearoa New Zealand University with a B Grade Average or better in at least 90 points of 300-level courses and have three years of work experience in a cognate eld; orii

### 5. Subjects

There are no majors, minors, or endorsements for this quali cation.

#### 6. Time limits

The time limit for this quali cation is 48 months.

#### 7. Transfers of credit, substitutions and cross-credits
