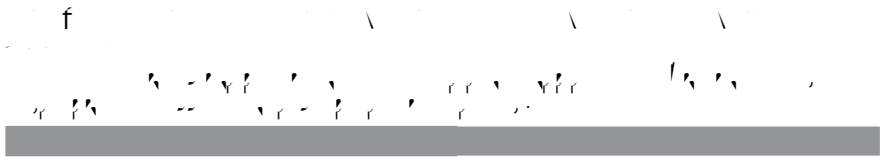

The Degree of Master of Fine Arts in Creative Writing (MFA(Creative Writing))

1. Qualifications Required to Enrol in the Degree

1. Candidates must have completed a Bachelor's degree with a minimum 2:1 classification in any discipline, or an equivalent qualification, or a Bachelor's degree with a minimum 2:2 classification in any discipline, or an equivalent qualification, or a Bachelor's degree with a minimum 2:2 classification in any discipline, or an equivalent qualification, or a Bachelor's degree with a minimum 2:2 classification in any discipline, or an equivalent qualification.

2. Admission in Special Cases

2. Candidates may be admitted to the degree on a special basis if they have completed a Bachelor's degree with a minimum 2:2 classification in any discipline, or an equivalent qualification, or a Bachelor's degree with a minimum 2:2 classification in any discipline, or an equivalent qualification, or a Bachelor's degree with a minimum 2:2 classification in any discipline, or an equivalent qualification.

3. Structure of the Degree

3. The degree consists of 10 units, of which 6 are compulsory and 4 are elective. The compulsory units are: MFA(Creative Writing) 10000, MFA(Creative Writing) 10001, MFA(Creative Writing) 10002, MFA(Creative Writing) 10003, MFA(Creative Writing) 10004, MFA(Creative Writing) 10005. The elective units are: MFA(Creative Writing) 10006, MFA(Creative Writing) 10007, MFA(Creative Writing) 10008, MFA(Creative Writing) 10009.

4. Candidates must have completed a Bachelor's degree with a minimum 2:1 classification in any discipline, or an equivalent qualification, or a Bachelor's degree with a minimum 2:2 classification in any discipline, or an equivalent qualification, or a Bachelor's degree with a minimum 2:2 classification in any discipline, or an equivalent qualification.

4. Part-time Study and Time Limits

4.1 Candidates may study part-time. The maximum period of study is 6 years for full-time students and 12 years for part-time students. 5. Master of Fine Arts in Creative Writing with Distinction and Merit

5.1 Candidates who complete the degree with a minimum 2:1 classification in all units are eligible for the award of a Master of Fine Arts in Creative Writing with Distinction. Candidates who complete the degree with a minimum 2:2 classification in all units are eligible for the award of a Master of Fine Arts in Creative Writing with Merit.
