- x Visitors/contract workers will not be in the hildren'stoileting area or sleep room with the knowledge and permission of the eam Leader will be supervised by a staff membeil children are inthetoileting area or sleep room.
- x Taking photos or videos of the children is prohibited unless permission has been sought and given by the parents / caregivers of the children present.

Research / student visitors

- x All research conducted at the Centrestrhave prior approvator the Manager who will first meet faceto-face with the researcher to obtain information of the research or study to be conducted.
- x All research carried out at the Centre and/or of Centre children must be approved by the relevant university's Ethics Committee or equivalent.
- x A copy of the research brief, consent letters and other relevant materials purid/based to ECLC staff andiled in the office.
- x Signed parent consent must be obtained before any child is involtheed nesearch.
- x No child information will be given to researcher / student by the Centess permission has been given by parent / guardian of child.
- x Any research work carried outtside of the Centre (e.g. in child's homeclinic or studio) is the responsibility of the parenguardian.
- x Taking photos or videos of the children at the Centre is prohibited unless permission has been sought and given by the parents / guardian of the children involved in the research.
- x All materials collected at the Centre must be kept confidential and private, in accordance with the research brief.
- x All students / researchers will observe the above guidelines relevant to all vissitoms Centre.
