SDG 8 Decent Work and Economic Growth

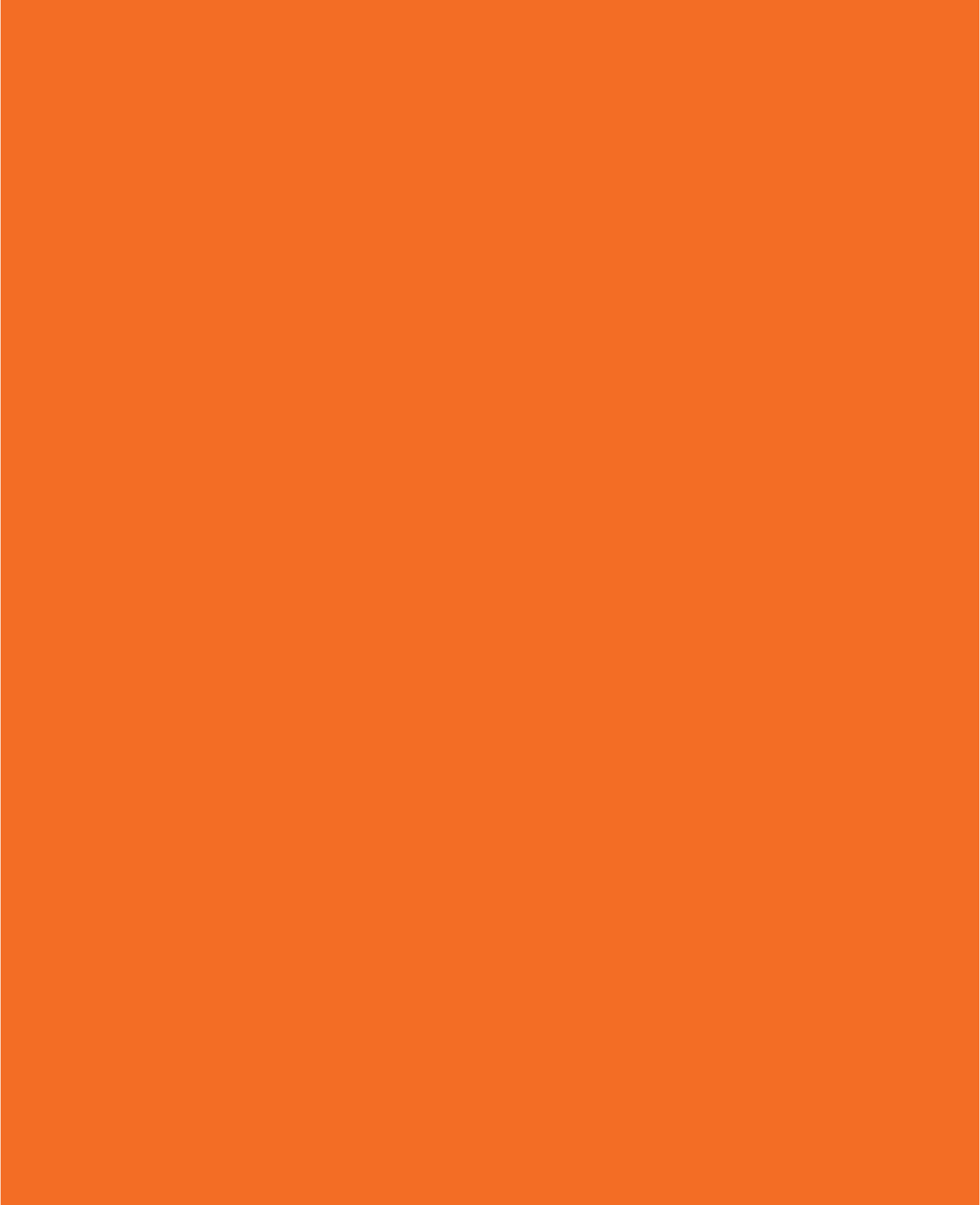

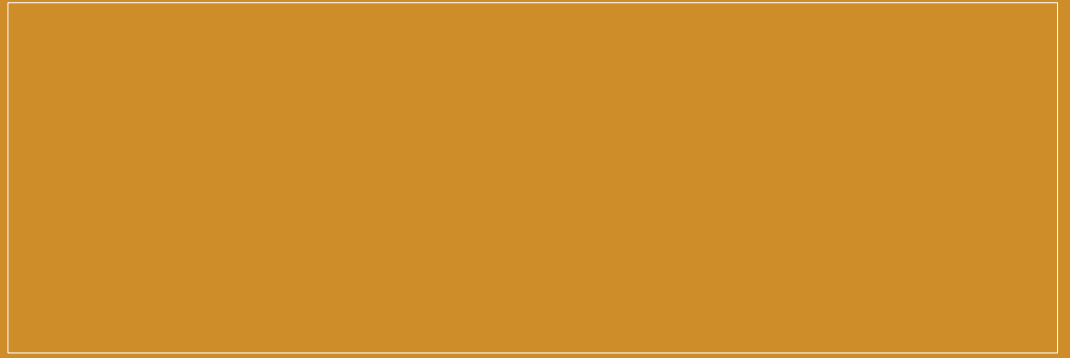

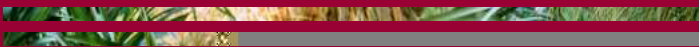
